### FULL -- \$295.00 (discount available if you are a first-time member of MPA)

**Requirements:** Master's level or higher degree in psychology and one year of experience practicing (Bachelor's degree plus five years working may be approved, contact staff).

### **SUSTAINING** -- \$410.00

**Requirements:** Must meet Full member requirements (Master's level or higher degree in psychology and one year of experience practicing).

#### **RETIRED** -- \$38.00
